**Report to New York State Training Council
September 30, 2009**

As of June 30, 2009, New York had 20,742 registered apprentices, a decrease from the 23,185 actives as of December.

The percentage for all female indentures is 9.57% or 1986 down from the 2206 total on December 31, 2008. Minority males total 32.01% or 6640 apprentices. That total is also a decrease of 583 from the December, 2008 level of 7223. Caucasian males total 58.41% or 12,116, reporting a decrease of 1640 apprentices.

The percentage levels of participation by all racial and gender groups in registered programs remains little changed during the reporting period.

By Labor Market and Economic Development Regions, the June 30, 2009 breakdown compared to December 31, 2008 is below:
